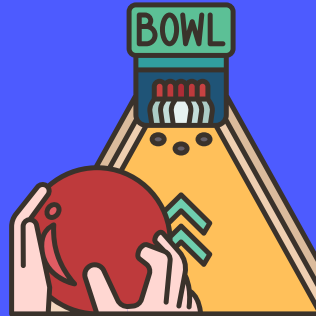

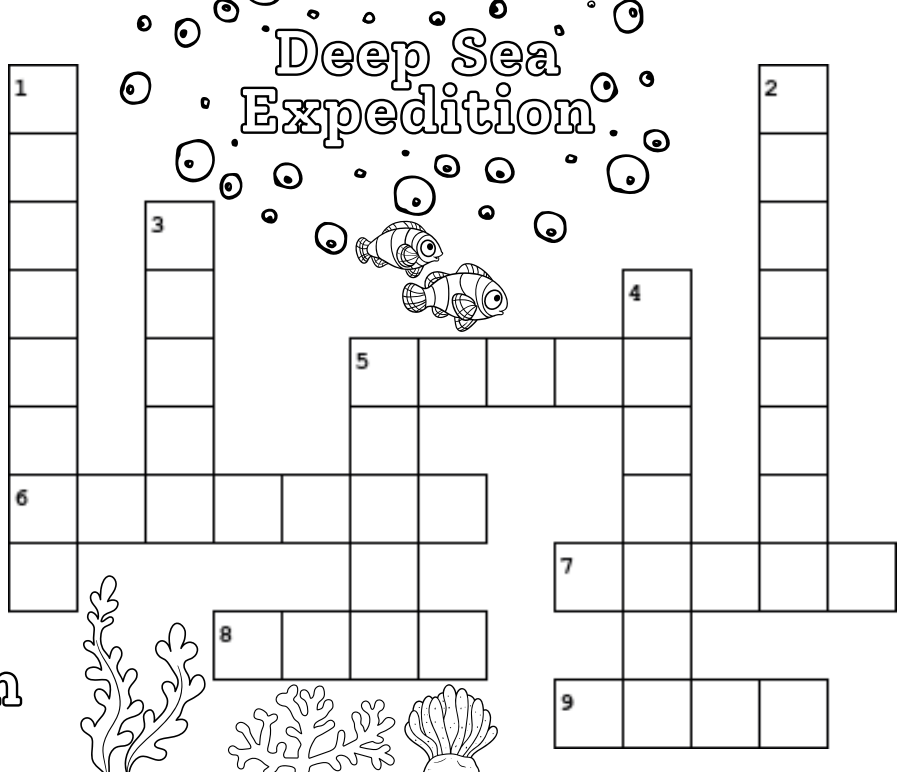
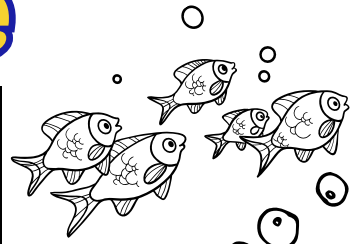


Ocean Puzzle Cove

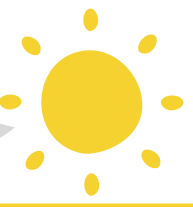
